

## Public Health Alert – stay at home restrictions

New [stay at home restrictions](#) were released on Monday 29 March and will apply immediately to anyone who visited Greater Brisbane since Saturday 20 March regardless of their current location.

If a person has returned from Greater Brisbane, which includes Brisbane, Logan, Moreton Bay, Ipswich and Redland Local Government Areas since 20 March 2021 must comply with the [Stay at Home Order](#) consistent with those living in identified areas in QLD until 5 pm Thursday 1 April 2021. This means they cannot attend work or come to school for this period.

Non-essential travel to Brisbane is not advisable at this time.

In addition, a number of locations in NSW have been identified to be associated with a COVID-19 case. The full list of locations is available on the [NSW Health website](#) along with the instructions you will be required to follow if you visited any of these sites during the specified date and time. This means:

- If a person has been to any of the **close contact locations** on the dates and during the times listed, they must get tested immediately and self-isolate for a period of 14 days from the time they attended the location. This means they will not be able to attend work or school for the full 14 day period.
- If a person has been to one of the **casual contact locations** on the dates and during the times listed, they must get tested and self-isolate until they receive a negative result. That means they cannot attend work or school until they receive confirmation of their negative result. Then they can return to their normal living arrangements.
