Reconciliation Walk 2021 Years 3–6 and K–2 ATSI students Tuesday 1 June 2021

This note is to inform you of details about the Reconciliation Walk 2021 and to seek your permission for your child to attend. Each year National Reconciliation Week (NRW) celebrates and builds on the respectful relationships shared by Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people and other Australians. The theme for 2021 is 'More Than a Word: Reconciliation Takes Action' with Reconciliation Australia inviting all Australians to learn more about Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander cultures and histories. The walk symbolises our journey of reconciliation and our need to recognise, remember and continue to learn about our nation's history. We ask students in Years 3-6 and any K-2 Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander students to take part in uncovering and exploring Aboriginal history and be a part of our nation's reconciliation journey.

When: Tuesday 1 June 2021

Where: Students will walk to Trinculo Place (under the Queens bridge) and gather at 10.00am where

they will eat recess. The walk will start at 10.30am and go over the Queens bridge, along Monaro St, and will end at the sunken gardens in Queanbeyan Park (corner of Campbell and Lowe streets). Once there, the official ceremony will begin followed by an Aboriginal cultural performance and flag raising ceremony. Students will eat their lunch at the park and then

walk back to school.

Time: 9:20am – 2:00pm.

Transport: Students will walk with teachers to Trinculo PI, along Monaro St to Queanbeyan Park, and

back to Queanbeyan East PS

Supervision: Staff from Queanbeyan East PS

What to wear: Full school uniform including a school hat and comfortable walking shoes.

What to bring: A water bottle, recess and lunch in a disposable bag (no lunch boxes).
