Meet the Teacher

To comply with COVID-19 guidelines our 'Meet the Teacher' event will be split into four sessions:

| Years 3 and 4 (Stage 2) | Wednesday 17 February 2021 | 4.30pm – 5.15pm |
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| Years 5 and 6 (Stage 3) | Wednesday 17 February 2021 | 5.30pm – 6.15pm |
| Kindergarten (Early Stage 1) | Thursday 18 February 2021 | 4.30pm – 5.15pm |
| Years 1 and 2 (Stage 1) | Thursday 18 February 2021 | 5.30pm – 6.15pm |

These sessions will be an opportunity for you to meet with your child's teacher and stage teachers. It will be an informal gathering and an opportunity to meet other families. Tea, coffee and light refreshments will be provided. Teachers will give a demonstration of Class Dojo and a general introduction to the year.

Meet the Teacher sessions will be held in the school hall. COVID Safe Plans and sign in procedures will be in place. Please enter the school through the staff carpark gate on Thurralilly Street. Supervision will not be provided for students.

School supplies

As a proud public school, we provide all the classroom resources that your child will need throughout the school year. If students in Years 3-6 would like to bring a pencil case with additional stationery, they are welcome to do so.

Students may also wish to bring in a set of headphones to use with their iPad (which are provided by the school). Headphones should have a 3.5mm jack (standard wired headphones) and be easily storable. Headphones are brought to school at own risk of damage. We have school headphones available which are cleaned and stored in classrooms, however, we encourage families to send in headphones for their child/children.

Voluntary Contributions
