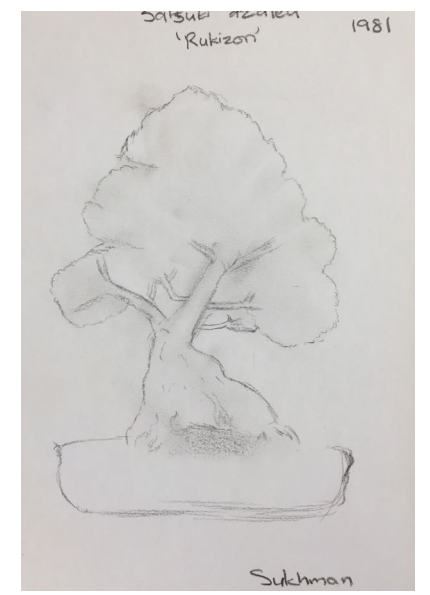
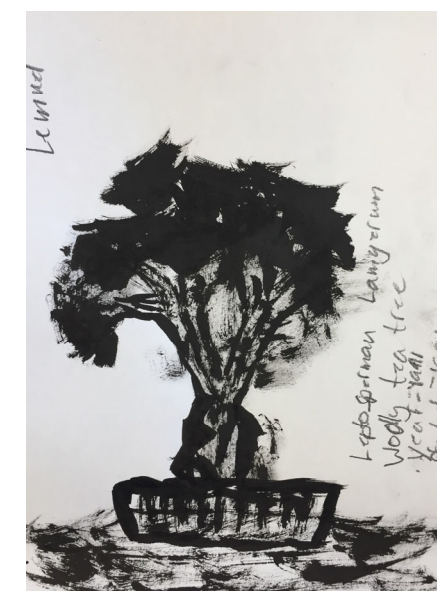
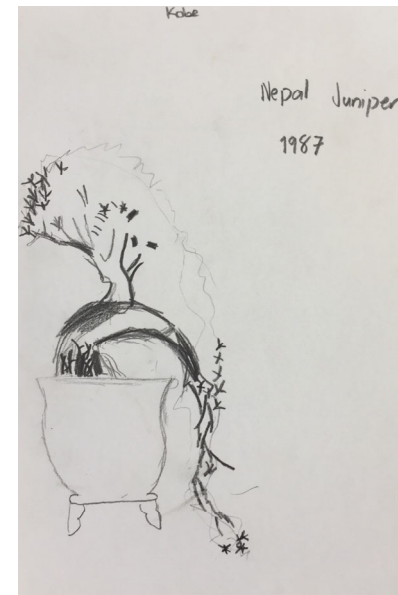
# The National Arboretum
